Tuition Contract

I wish my child to take **Drum Kit** lessons with **Mr Gary Beggs**. I understand that they will have 30 Shared lessons spaced throughout the academic year at the cost of £225 (£7.50 per lesson) to be paid in full by **8th September** (post-dated) 2025. **(No cheques will be cashed before the first lesson in September).**

Payment can be made in one of three ways:

In one cheque/cash/transfer £225 dated 8th September 2025.

In three cheques of £75 dated 8th September 2025, 1st January 2025 & 1st April 2026

In ten bank transfer payments of £22.50 on the first of each month September 2025 through to June 2026 (inclusive).

I further understand that I have secured my child's place by signing this contract. I will forward the fees to Mr Gary Beggs by 8th September, and am aware that they cannot be cashed until 8th September 2025. I am glad that Ballymagee Primary School have permitted these lessons to take place in their building. However, I understand and agree that the responsibility for all aspects of these lessons remains strictly between Mr Gary Beggs and myself. I understand I will be given Mr Gary Beggs contact details and Mr Gary Beggs will have mine.

All cheques are to be made payable to Mr Gary Beggs. I understand that lessons are for a complete year and there will be no refunds. Cancellations policy – This is a 10-month contract. If a pupil has to cancel a lesson due to illness they must do so at least 24 hours in advance, otherwise pupils must allow two weeks notice for cancellation. Lessons will be rotated in order to minimise disruption. Lessons will not begin until payment has been made. Pupils must bring their own drumsticks and books to lessons.
